






1. Go to justgiving.com and click on the Start fundraising button








2. Click on the Start fundraising button again








3. Sign up by completing the form. Make sure to enter your email address, first name, last name and choose a password








4. Select your country, enter your postcode then search to select your address








5. Search for The Prince & Princess of Wales Hospice in the search bar. Then click select.








6. Select one of the four options and complete the details.







7. If you selected Taking part in an event on the previous page, you can now search for your chosen event. Don't worry if it doesn't appear, you can choose to add your own.










9. Congratulations! Your page is now set up. We'll now explain how you can personalise it to encourage your friends and family to support you. First, click on the personalise button.








10. You can tell your story on this page and explain why you have chosen to support the hospice. Keep it as minimal or as detailed at you wish, but remember that anyone visiting your JustGiving page can read it. You can also set your fundraising goal for what you would like to achieve in sponsorship. Click Save and continue when you've finished.








11. Next, click on the Edit your page button so you can add more information about your fundraising.








- 12. Click edit to change your picture and change the headline page name

 - 15. You can set-up a text code to make it easy for people to donate to your page.








16. You can easily share your page via social media and email17. You can start a team with other people or connect with your company








19. Post updates and add photos of your fundraising journey to add a personal touch.
